About the program

Library Express was developed for isolated Braintree residents as a partnership between Thayer Public Library, Friends of Thayer Public Library and Braintree Department of Elder Affairs.

Our mission is to provide access to library material to homebound residents of Braintree. There are no age limitations.

This is a biweekly delivery with a limit of five (5) items per visit. No renewals or holds will be allowed on library materials.



Who is eligible

Library Express is a free service for Braintree residents who are unable to leave their homes due to a health or social service issue that lasts (12) twelve weeks or more.



How to register

If you are interested, call the Assistant Library Director at 781-848-0405 x4414. If you do not have a library card, one will be issued.

To help you apply for the program, a home visit will be scheduled with a Friends volunteer and a representative of the Braintree Department of Elder Affairs.

Requesting materials

Once you have joined the Library Express program, each time the Friends visit, you will get a blank Request Form. You may choose your own books, music, movies and other materials by filling out the Request Form. You can write down names of specific titles or write the type of material you want, for example, Romance, Action DVD, or Mystery Large Print.

Materials you have requested will not always be available. You can always re-request items.
